Ideal candidate will have knowledge and understanding of workers' compensation and governmental entity operations. Applicants must have a minimum of 3 years' experience in safety and loss control, working in or with local government or a combination of both. Completion of college coursework preferred. Must be proficient with personal computer and Microsoft products. Should be highly organized with excellent attention to detail. Effective communication skills, both oral and written, a must. Must have a valid Iowa Drivers' license, clean driving record and must be insurable. Position requires extensive in-state travel with a limited amount of out-of-state travel. Approximately one day per week dedicated to meetings with staff and other office work, in the Des Moines office.
